## Dr. Robert (Ibrahim) Jaffe on Light

We teach people how to begin to find the pictures carried in the unconscious mind which carry all the wounding that holds the energetics of the disease in place. Once they understand those pictures and learn how to release them through the divine love, the pictures disappear and are replaced by the pure light of divine love, which is perfect in its nature. Once that light comes through, there are no pictures of disease, there's only love. And in the experience of love, the physical disease disappears with it....

Somebody came to the Institute who had breast cancer, which I had not had a whole lot of success with at that point. I watched how [my Sufi teacher healed others]. What he did was to invoke very, very high levels from God directly and bring through the purest light I've ever seen in the healing process. And as the light of God, which I call Love, moved through the disease, it took the disease from the person and the tumor disappeared.

I said, "Tell me exactly what you're doing." He said that what he's doing is that through his own transformation in proximity to God, he was able to call forth this light. Once he could invoke it, the Light transformed disease. We talked about how does one come into proximity to God so that they can access this pure Light. This is what he calls "walking," the transformation of the heart so that one becomes the divine vessel of God....

First of all, you have to know the divine Light. This is the first major step. Most people really don't know the difference between the divine Light and illusionary light inside themselves, so our first step is to teach people what is God, what is the Light of God and how do you know the difference between that and the other light.

The second step is how to align with that Light and listen to it and follow it. Once a person does those things, the rest gets pretty easy. Now as they're moving through life, things are going to come up on a day-to-day basis which are opportunities for them to make choices between moving closer to Love, the divine Light, or staying with the world or their personality or ego or something else. Step by step, day by day, the person moves deeper and deeper into the divine Light of God and begins to dispel all the illusion, desires and attachments to the outside. In time, the only thing that's left is the pure Oneness of God....

We've since got all the buildings standing on their feet and some have been completely remodeled. We have four springs that come out of the ground which, if you can see clairvoyantly, you'll see that the light that comes out is pure white. It's a very holy ground.
